As Senior Vice President of the Affiliate Network, Carol Corcoran leads Susan G. Komen for the Cure's unique network of more than 120 local Affiliates in the United States and internationally. Komen for the Cure's Affiliate Network is the most extensive of any breast cancer organization, providing more than \$1.3 billion to fund local screening, patient navigations, education and social and financial support to hundreds of thousands of people facing breast cancer in communities worldwide.

As Komen nears its 30th Anniversary, Corcoran is charged with providing strategic leadership to strengthen and grow the Affiliate Network for the future. She brings to Komen a wealth of knowledge and experience in guiding and managing organizational growth and change.

She most recently was president of the LPGA Foundation, where she also served as chief administrative officer and senior vice president of Human Resources. During her tenure, she designed and implemented an organizational restructuring to support the LPGA Foundation's "Strategy 2010" initiative.

Corcoran also served as a senior human resources consultant to NIKE, Inc., providing strategic direction and oversight through the divestiture of a Nike subsidiary and designing a disciplined engagement and integration process for future acquisitions. Prior to NIKE, she was senior vice president of Human Resources and Diversity for the Tufts Health Plan in Waltham, Mass., and held senior executive level administrative and human resources positions at the wellness organization Canyon Ranch, Inc., of Tucson, Ariz.; at Weber-Shandwick Worldwide, and Blue Cross/Blue Shield of New Hampshire, Inc.

Corcoran graduated *cum laude* in political science from Northeastern University in Boston. She is a member of the Human Resource Leadership Forum (HRLF); Northeast Human Resources Association (NEHRA); Human Resources Health Care Forum; Human Rights Campaign, Advisory Council; The Commonwealth Institute Advisory Council and Leadership New Hampshire.
